

Measures to protect visitors against coronavirus during their visit to the Centre of Antiquity

Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier and Roman Monuments

Valid from the 14th of October 2021

Dear visitors,

Your health is important to us! Below you can find hygiene and safety measures to follow, as well as information about current restrictions on the range of services in the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier and the Trier Roman Monuments.

We look forward to welcoming you to our sites and would be incredibly grateful if you could follow these measures when visiting the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier and Trier Roman Monuments.

General hygiene and safety measures in accordance with the Corona Control Ordinance that is currently in force in Rhineland-Palatinate

- Access only for people who are **vaccinated, recovered, or tested (certificate is required)**. Exceptions apply to children under the age of eleven and school classes.
- Visitors must **provide their contact details**, see our website contact form, or register by luca app.
- A **surgical mask** or a KN95/N95 or FFP2 standard mask must be worn at all times when visiting the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier and the Forum Baths, as well as the indoor areas of the Trier Roman Monuments Porta Nigra and the Imperial Baths. This must be kept on at all times during your visit of the Museum and in the indoor areas of the Roman Monuments.

Exceptions apply to children under the age of six and people with health-related or physical restrictions that prevent them from wearing a mask (a medical certificate is required as proof).

- A distance of at least 1.5 metres from other visitors and museum staff must be maintained at all times
This measure does not apply to members of the same family or household.
- Avoid forming groups in front of the entrance and in the exhibition rooms/areas.
- Please observe the maximum number of visitors permitted per room/area.
- The tour of the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier and Roman Monuments Porta Nigra, the Imperial Baths and the Forum Baths has been designed as a “one-way route” and will stay this way until further notice.
- Hand sanitiser stations can be found throughout the Museum / sites. Please wash or sanitise your hands regularly.

- The show “In the Realm of Shadows”
- Events, tours, workshops and group visits restricted

We are currently unable to offer the following services in the TRIER ROMAN MONUMENTS:

- Multimedia guides
- Media stations restricted
- Screening of informative films restricted
- Events, tours, workshops and group visits restricted

Please note our **new opening times** when visiting the **Forum Baths**, which are open from Tuesday to Sunday between 11am and 5pm.
