

Information about group visits at the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier and Roman Monuments

Valid from the 26th of August 2021

Group visits **WITHOUT** a guide at the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier

The maximum group size is **10 people** (Roman Section) or 6 people (special exhibition) plus a guide. **School classes** can visit the museum in **class size**, plus 2 chaperones.

The following hygiene and protective measures must be observed before / during the visit:

- Access only for people who are **vaccinated, recovered, or tested (certificate is required)**. Exceptions apply to children under the age of fourteen and school classes.
- **Obligation to book in advance for school classes:** Please register your visit to the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier (or the Roman Monuments) by email to landesmuseum-trier@gdke.rlp.de and let us know the number of visitors and the time of your planned visit. You can reach us between 9am and 4pm from Monday to Thursday and between 9am and 12 noon on Friday.
- **Provide contact details, see our website contact form** (for school classes, contact details must be provided for the school and the accompanying teacher and the surnames of all visiting children must also be provided).
- A surgical face mask or **KN95/N95 or FFP2 standard** face mask must be worn at all times. Exceptions apply to children under the age of six and people with health-related or physical restrictions that prevent them from wearing a mask (a medical certificate is required as proof).
- A **distance of at least 1.5 metres** from other visitors and museum staff must be maintained at all times. This does not apply to members of the same family or household.
- Please observe the **maximum number of visitors** allowed per room.
- The tour of the Rheinisches Landesmuseum Trier has been designed as a **one-way route** and will stay this way until further notice.
- **Hand sanitiser stations** can be found throughout the Museum. Please wash or sanitise your hands regularly.
- Only the halls in the "Roman Section" can be visited by entire groups at the same time.

If there is a high number of visitors, you may experience longer waiting times.

Group visit **WITHOUT** a guide in the Trier Roman Monuments Porta Nigra, Ampitheater, the Imperial Baths and the Forum Baths

The maximum group size for these monuments is as follows:

- Porta Nigra / **max. 15 people** plus one guide
- Ampitheater / **max. 25 people** plus one guide
- Imperial Baths / **max. 25 people** plus one guide
- Forum Baths / **max. 20 people** plus one guide

- **School classes can book a tour at the museum in class size, plus 2 chaperones. The maximum number of other groups** allowed for a guided tour of the Roman Section of the permanent exhibition is **10 plus a guide** and the maximum number of visitors allowed for a guided tour of the special exhibition “ECHO. The Aura of Antiquity: Werner Kroener” is **6 plus a guide**.
- The **maximum tour length is 60 mins**. Cost: € 55 plus the admission fee (group and family discounts available)
- Alongside the hygiene and protective measures mentioned above, the following additional measures must also be observed: visitors must sanitise their hands before starting the tour.
