40 YEARS OF UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE “ROMAN MONUMENTS, ST. PETER’S CATHEDRAL AND CHURCH OF OUR LADY IN TRIER”

Trier is internationally renowned for its exceptional monuments that bring to life the former splendor of a Roman imperial metropolis. The UNESCO World Heritage Site “Roman Monuments, Cathedral of St. Peter and Church of Our Lady in Trier” comprises nine outstanding buildings – including the Porta Nigra, the Imperial Baths, the Roman Bridge, the Amphitheatre, the Barbara Baths, and the Igel Column. They illustrate Trier’s importance within the Roman Empire and the city’s ecclesiastical history, which continues to this day. Owing to this uniqueness, Trier was inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1986.
